As many of you are aware, the Columbine Valley Police Department is dispatched through the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office. The Sheriff's Office is now billing each agency that it provides dispatch services for; based on the number of calls received. Due to these billing changes, we are asking that you follow some simple guidelines when calling the police for service.

When to call Arapahoe County Dispatch: **911** (emergency) **303-795-4711** (non-emergency)

- Any emergency situation
- Any crime in progress
- Any suspicious activity or persons
- Anytime you need to speak with an officer immediately, and the Town Office is closed.

When to call the Town Office to speak with an officer: 303-795-1434

- If you need to follow up with an officer about a previous case.
- If you need to speak to an officer about a situation or ask a question.
- To request a parking permit
- To request an increased patrol
- Animal complaints

These are only a few examples to help you decide which number is appropriate. If at anytime you are not sure which is the correct number, we ask that you call Dispatch to ensure you receive the appropriate response.

Officers can be contacted through the Town Office during business hours only. If the Town Office is closed, you may either leave a voicemail for the officer you are trying to contact, or request contact through Dispatch at 303-795-4711. Additionally, all officers email addresses are available on our website.

A House Watch can be requested at the Columbine Valley Police Department at 303-795-1434, or preferably at our website at www.Columbinevalley.org. Please do not call the Arapahoe County Sheriff to request a House Watch.
